

AMENDMENT TO AMENDED AND RESTATED  
DISTRICT INFORMATION FORM

The District Information Form for Harris County Water Control & Improvement District No. 156 is hereby amended as follows:

3. The most recent rate of district taxes on property located in the district is \$0.247 per \$100 assessed valuation.

9. The form of Notice to Purchasers required by Section 49.452 of the Texas Water Code as furnished by a seller to a purchaser of real property in the District, is to read as follows:

Notice to Purchaser

The real property, described below, which you are about to purchase is located in Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 156. The district has taxing authority separate from any other taxing authority, and may, subject to voter approval, issue an unlimited amount of bonds and levy an unlimited rate of tax in payment of such bonds. As of this date, the rate of taxes levied by the district on real property located in the district is \$0.247 on each \$100 of assessed valuation. If the district has not yet levied taxes, the most recent projected rate of tax, as of this date, is \$N/A on each \$100 of assessed valuation. The total amount of bonds, excluding refunding bonds and any bonds or any portion of bonds issued that are payable solely from revenues received or expected to be received under a contract with a governmental entity, approved by the voters and which have been or may, at this date, be issued is \$10,000,000 plus refunding authorization, and the aggregate initial principal amounts of all bonds issued for one or more of the specified facilities of the district and payable is whole or in part from property taxes is \$5,995,000.

The district has the authority to adopt and impose a standby fee on property in the district that has water, sewer, sanitary, or drainage facilities and services available but not connected and which does not have a house, building, or other improvement located thereon and does not substantially utilize the utility capacity available to the property. The district may exercise the authority without holding an election on the matter. As of this date, the amount of the standby fee is \$0.00. An unpaid standby fee is a personal obligation of the person that owned the property at the time of imposition and is secured by a lien on the property. Any person may request a certificate from the district stating the amount, if any, of unpaid standby fees on a tract of property in the district.

Land in the District is located within either the City of Pasadena, Texas, or Houston, Texas, and under certain circumstances the District may be dissolved and the function of the District taken over by such Cities. The land within the District was formerly in the Clear Lake City Water Authority and could be consolidated with the Authority in the future.

The purpose of this district is to provide water, sewer, drainage, or flood control facilities and services within the district through the issuance of bonds payable in whole or in part from property taxes. The cost of these utility facilities is not included in the purchase price of your property, and these utility facilities are owned or to be owned by the district. The legal description of the property which you are acquiring is as follows:

If the District has not yet levied taxes, a statement of the district's most recent projected rate of tax, if any, is to be placed in the appropriate space. If the district does not have approval from the commission to adopt and impose a standby fee, the second paragraph of the notice may be deleted. For the purposes of the notice form required to be given to the prospective purchaser prior to execution of a binding contract of sale and purchase, a seller and any agent, representative, or person acting on his behalf may modify the notice by substitution of the words "January 1, 20\_\_" for the words "this date" and place the correct calendar year in the appropriate space.)

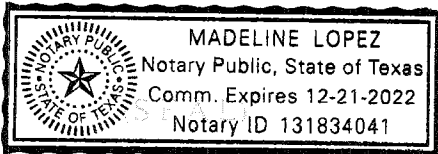
