

# STAGE ONE WATER RESTRICTIONS NOW IN EFFECT

The Clear Lake City Water Authority is implementing Stage One (1) Water Restrictions, of the Authority's Drought Contingency Plan, effective August 27, 2023. Due to the significant drop in annual rainfall, higher-than-normal daily temperatures, and number of main breaks causing stress on the water system.

During Stage One, it is requested that the public take the following voluntary conservation measures:

- All irrigation should take place between the hours of 7 PM and 5 AM.
- Check for leaks, dripping faucets, and running toilets and utilize water conservation kits such as displacement bags for toilet tanks and low-flow shower heads.
- Practice water conservation and minimize or discontinue water use for non-essential purposes (irrigation of landscape; washing vehicles, sidewalks, driveways, buildings, or gutters; or filling recreational pools, fountains, or aesthetic /scenic ponds (except where necessary to support aquatic life)).

The CLCWA asks the public to please follow the above practices to help reduce citywide water usage. Our goal is to reduce water usage by 5%. Our crews are working diligently to repair water leaks, please help us by reporting any new leaks.
